


## Golf Course Improvement Report No.4



November 2022



To the Board and Members of the Brookside Country Club,

Once again, I would like to thank all of you for the opportunity to work on your golf course. It's been an exciting season here at the Brookside Country Club! We have seen a healthy amount of tree removal, renewed bunker style and strategy, and some interesting expansions to the fairways and greens. Our work has been crafted to fully consider the long term sustainability and ease of maintenance for the golf course. This will be accomplished by reducing the total square footage of bunker sand to be maintained as well as newly installed drainage in all the bunkers. We will also be reducing regularly mown rough and converting over three acres (130,680 sq/ft) to a blend of native grass which will add a beautiful aesthetic and strategic texture to the golf course in the summer and fall.

The following pictures illustrate our work before and after on the 13th hole. We plan to have the bunker sand installed over the winter and look forward to playing next year!

- Green expansions holes #1,2,11,16
- Fairway expansion holes #1, 2, 3, 11, 13, 14, 16
- Chipping area + 2 new practice bunkers
- New bunker
- New greens turf nursery
- Filled and covered stump holes throughout the golf course
- 6 New bunkers added / 7 bunkers deleted
- Net change -(8000 sq/ft) sand to be maintained
- Over 150 trees cleared from playing areas

- Finish shaping fairway bunker hole #11
